Another successful year at FBW Gynaecology Plus!

Dr Fariba Behnia-Willison had a busy year in 2019 teaching, presenting and networking with specialists, medical practitioners, scientists and businesses leading the way in Regenerative Medicine.

Dr Fariba Behnia-Willison, Dr Tran Nguyen were inspired at the AGES Annual Scientific Meeting and the AGES Pelvic Floor Symposium in March, speaking with and learning from keynote speakers! We were also proud to announce that Dr Fariba Behnia-Willison had been elected as a board member for the Australasian Gynaecological Endoscopy and Surgery Society (AGES) and has spent the year working hard with other board members to advance education and mentorship. Dr Tran Nguyen also received her AGES Fellowship at the Annual Scientific Meeting Event!

In June Dr Willison travelled to London for the **RCOG World Congress** where she presented on innovative treatments of incontinence and prolapse such as PRP and also regenerative medicine for managing mesh complications.

Dr Willison and Dr Ritossa as AGES Board Members organised the "Who do you want to be when you grow up" AGES Seminar for trainees in Adelaide in July. They used this event to give direction to our future generation of O&G consultants! In July we also held our first FBW Annual GP Seminar with Dr Willison and Dr Nguyen presenting to General Practitioners on commonly asked questions. Dr Willison and Dr Nguyen also attended the ASCCP Management of Cervical Disease and Colposcopy Course in Sydney to finish of a very busy month!

The August issue of **Women's Weekly Magazine** featured Khadija Gbla and her fight to stop Female Genital Mutilation (FGM) and our very own Dr Fariba Behnia-Willison's medical

expertise in the reversal and treatment for survivors through our clinic and charity **Desert Flower Centre Australia.**

In August the combined **AGES and World Endometriosis Society Conference** in Melbourne was a sensational meeting on endometriosis and fertility treatment. Dr Fariba Willison and Dr Tran Nguyen updated their knowledge to care for women holistically and Dr Willison presented on the Limits and Limitations of Surgery and Endometriosis.

Dr Willison also took part in the **Flinders Endogynaecology Suturing Workshop** in August, presenting on her experience with Mesh Hysteropexy in Pelvic Floor Prolapse and conducting suturing workshops with the Flinders Endogynaecology Team.

Dr. Willison was pleased to attend the **AGES 'Train the Trainer' Workshop** in Sydney in October. She strives to keep up to date with the latest information and technology through training and research.

In November Dr Willison and Dr Nguyen both attended the **AAGL 2019 Conference** in Vancouver. Dr Willison held a workshop to fellow international surgeons on Regenerative Medicine for Gynaecology, Lasers and New Treatments in Vulvovaginal and Pelvic Floor Conditions and Pelvic Floor Repair with the use of Autologous Graft in Vaginal Surgery.

She finished off a year full of education and assisting with the **AGES Laparoscopic Anatomy and Pelvic Dissection Workshop** in Brisbane, what a year it has been!

We could not continue the work that we so love to do at FBW Gynaecology Plus without your continued support and we look forward to an even more inspiring and educational year ahead in 2020!

What will 2020 bring to FBW Gynaecology Plus

The next year ahead for FBW Gynaecology Plus will continue to be full of education and research, conferences and workshops!

Dr Tran Nguyen will be continuing her Masters in Reproductive Medicine and be focused on restorative fertility, which is aimed at repairing the underlying medical conditions to improve overall fertility.

We will be delving into a study on Radio-frequency with the **Viveve System** for treatment of Urinary Incontinence. This TGA-approved treatment works at a cellular level to rebuild and restore collagen within the vaginal tissue – without the need of surgery and without disrupting the mucosal surface.

During one 45-minute in outpatiet visit, the Viveve treatment delivers patented, dual-mode deep heating and surface cooling to stimulate the body's own natural regenerative processes. In multiple studies, including the **VIVEVE 1 study**, a large randomised controlled trial, women who received the Viveve showed statistically significant and sustained improvements in vaginal tightness, sensation and satisfaction at 12 months follow-up. The **VIVEVE 1 study** also showed statistically significant improvement in arousal, lubrication, and orgasm.

We will be commencing research on the use of the Viveve for patients with Urinary Incontinence and also for patients suffering from FGM.



Desert Flower Centre Australia - Activism 2019



In 2018, Dr Behnia-Willison founded Desert Flower Foundation Australia, a charity which raises awareness of FGM and provides medical help to repair and reverse its effects. She has put together a team of nurses and anaesthetists who, with the support of Adelaide's Ashford Hospital, have provided free reconstructive surgery to women who have suffered from FGM.

In the past two years, she has operated on 12 women but seen at least 50 women through her clinic from all over the world seeking help. Some do not proceed with surgery for fear of community or family reprisal. Of those that do, she says: "It has been joyful seeing the confidence these women have afterwards. It makes a big difference to their lives." Dr Behnia-Willison has joined Khadija's campaign to educate about the impacts of FGM.

In our first year since launching Desert Flower Centre Australia we have collaborated with **PsychMed** to provide awareness and trauma training and worked with our team at FBW to build the foundations of this charity.

Khadija Gbla and Dr Fariba Behnia-Willison were featured in **Women's Weekly Magazine** in their **Inspiring Women Issue** and we continued to treat patients in our clinic!

Recent years of the Rat are: 1924, 1936, 1948, 1960, 1972, 1984, 1996, 2008, 2020.




Fertility Awareness

"Beauty has no age, Fertility does."

There has been a shift in culture, where women have been more focused on education and establishing their career. As a result, fertility may be delayed until a later age. However, advanced female age, which is when women are over 35 years of age, is related to fewer and poorer-quality follicles, higher risk of aneuploidy and miscarriage, as well as obstetric and perinatal complications.

Hence postponing childbearing may have longterm effects on women's lives and should be addressed in their early age.

It is important to introduce fertility awareness to women and couples about the unmodifiable risk factor of female age. The vitrification technology has improved the ability for egg freezing, which allows women to preserve fertility until their desired time to enter motherhood.

PTNS treatment program is effective for men and women. It is a 30-minute **Bulk** Billed weekly session for 12 weeks at no cost to the patients! Many studies show up to 80% of patient improve with PTNS, with less bothersome symptoms and social embarrassment.
